



Sutton United Away Fan Letter

We are excited to welcome A.F.C. Telford United on November 1st at 15:00. The following information should provide all the necessary details for away fans visiting us at Gander Green Lane.

- Turnstiles for this match will be open at 13:00 (Subject to change).
- Ticket prices for this match are as follows:
 - Adults - £15
 - Concessions (62+, Blue Light Card Holders and Students) - £10
 - Juniors (14- 17 years old) - £5
 - U14 - £2
 - Disabled carers are admitted free (contact the SUFC ticket office for more information).
- A limited number of tickets will be available for purchase from the away turnstiles with a £3 price increase per ticket (Note, we are a cashless stadium).
- There are no seats in the away end, but we do allow away fans who can't stand for long periods to sit in our main stand. Your fans who require seating can purchase these tickets by contacting tickets@suttonunited.net
- We do not allow away fans to bring drums into our stadium due to our proximity to residential areas.

Food and Beverage

- All bars, food stalls, and ticket kiosks are now cashless.
- The bars and food kiosk will be open from 13:00.
- There will be vegan and vegetarian food options.

Getting Here

By Car

- Travel along the M25 to junction 8. Then north on the A217 for about 15-20 minutes. Stay on the A217 to the traffic lights with the Cheam Road (A232) and turn right toward Sutton. Do not turn into

Gander Green Lane, keep going until you reach the Sutton one-way system and turn left into St Nicholas Way and then left again into the Gibson Road municipal car park. It is then a relatively short walk down Collingwood Road to the away end of the stadium.

By Rail

- It is recommended that visiting supporters use Sutton station, which is on the main lines out of Victoria and London Bridge and is at the top end of Sutton High Street, about 20 20-minute walk from the ground. Two buses between Morden and Sutton stations run conveniently close to our stadium: route 413 bus goes down Gander Green Lane, and number 80 bus runs along Collingwood Road. The ground can then be reached by taking the path through Collingwood Rec. London Buses are now cashless.
- Our closest station to the stadium is West Sutton station (about a 3-minute walk from the stadium).

Parking

- We do not offer general admission parking. On match days, the club car park in Gander Green Lane is for parking permit holders only. Away fans should park in Gibson Road, the local municipal car-park. It takes no more than fifteen minutes to walk from Gibson Road to the stadium.

Disabled Facilities

- Sutton United FC welcomes disabled supporters and, in line with the club's equality policy, disabled supporters have access to all facilities open to of able-bodied supporters where possible.
- There is no general admission to our car park on match days. Disabled parking is available for blue badge holders; but it should be booked in advance by emailing info@suttonunited.net, giving as much notice as possible, please. As an alternative to parking at the ground, spectators with mobility issues can use bus route 413, which stops virtually outside the ground in Gander Green Lane. All London buses are accessible
- To guarantee availability for wheelchair access, please book in advance by emailing info@suttonunited.net, and we would ask that this is done before buying your match ticket.
